

**TEXAS BAPTIST INSTITUTE & SEMINARY 2022 REPORT TO THE  
CHURCHES OF THE TEXAS STATE ASSOCIATION**

I would like to make a very simple report concerning Texas Baptist Institute & Seminary for this 2022-2023 school year.

First, our enrollment for this year remains strong. Between the main campus and Extension Learning Centers around the state we are teaching 118 students in this Fall Semester. Plans are being made to increase the number of Extension Learning Centers with the possibility of placing some outside of Texas.

Second, our finances are remaining strong. Thank you for your support.

Third, Trustees have adopted proposed changes in facility plans. Phase 1 will include a new parking lot, security lights, parking in front of apartments, and decorative security fencing around all properties. This is approximately a 2-million-dollar project. Please help us achieve this goal.

Fourth, as of the week of February 12, 2023, we will know if we have received accreditation with the Association of Biblical Higher Education. We HAVE NOT compromised and WILL NOT COMPROMISE any of our doctrinal beliefs in the pursuit of accreditation.

Fifth, our President, Dr. Ray O. Brooks, will turn 100 in March of 2023. We will celebrate this milestone in the life of Bro. Brooks in March and at TBI Commencement in May.

Sixth and finally, at the end of this school year, the last day of June 2023, Dr. Ray Brooks will become President Emeritus and Dr. Steve Butler will assume the office of President/CEO as per the vote of Trustees.
