Bro. Devine's early work is difficult to fit onto a traditional spreadsheet, so, I thought it best to summarize the work that the Devine family has been doing in the Rosharon, Texas area.

Since April, the Devine family has been meeting for Sunday night Bible study with people that have joined them from their community. Their attendance averages in the mid-teens with an occasional high of 21 in attendance. Greg and Amy serve at the local pregnancy center and Greg has witnessed to different young men, and Amy has seen around 18 young women and led one to Christ!

They have further invested time in learning the Celebrate Recovery ministry in hopes of having that as a part of their impactful ministry. They have made a lot of friends and local contacts in their short time on the field thus far, and have networked with those to make new contacts as well.

The Devines receive \$4000 a month support from the MBA of Texas.


